

SALE OF WORK AT GLASGOW.—A sale of work in connection with St Andrew's Parish Church, Glasgow (the Rev. James Thomson, minister), was opened yesterday in the Church House, St Andrew Square. The object of the sale is to raise a sum of £95—£20 for home and congregational missions, a similar sum for female foreign missions, £25 to provide working material for next year, and £30 for the Boys' Brigade.
