Focus on... Day Services

Kibble Day Services support children and young people who need additional help to engage with learning and become responsible citizens. All pupils have their own dedicated key worker who provides them with personalised support.

This can involve:

- Support in classes to encourage achievement
- Focused key time which encourages pro-social behaviour
- Support to access sustainable community-based leisure activities
- Family work to help rebuild relationships particularly where there is a risk of the young person being removed from the family home
- A holiday programme that offers a full range of activities which benefit health and wellbeing, relationships and teamwork

Good attendance is crucial to this work and a huge emphasis is put on getting the kids to school. As a result, we have achieved dramatic increases in attendance, in some cases from 0 to 100%!

Day pupils can access a full primary, secondary or senior phase curriculum. We personalise learning and develop activities to meet the needs of individual young people.
