

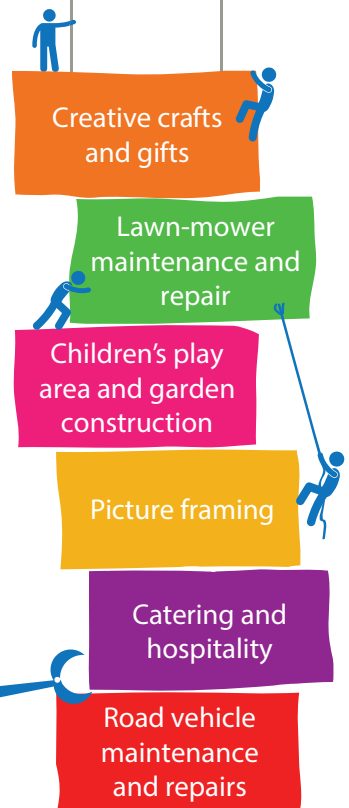


KibbleWorks forms part of Kibble's youth training and employment service, and is underpinned by our senior education programme. We provide a broad spectrum of flexible training, work experience and employment opportunities for young people aged 16 to 24 who are in care, preparing to leave care or whose needs cannot be addressed within the wider community. Every young person will have an individual learning plan and will be working towards City and Guilds, SVQ or other nationally recognised qualifications at a level appropriate to their needs and aspirations. Young people are supported by staff who are dual qualified: holding both vocational trade and residential care qualifications. Following a modern apprenticeship model, young people work in a structured environment which provides real life learning opportunities supported by a maximum of 2-1 tuition. In addition to gaining practical experience, young people will acquire a range of transferable skills such as team work, punctuality, time management, customer care, attitudes towards work and health and safety within the workplace. They will also develop positive, respectful relationships with their colleagues and employer. KibbleWorks forms part of a throughcare programme for each young person which includes effective personal support, employability support and improved access to employment, further education or training.
