



Integrated Services - Improved Outcomes

Kibble is Scotland's specialist provider of child and youth care services. We provide specialist care to young people (5-24) who have complex social, emotional, behavioural and educational problems.

The following aspects ensure young people get the best outcomes possible:

• Service Integration:

All services from our primary school to our 16+ employment and training services are carefully designed to maximise seamless integration, meaning that young people can move between our different services with real continuity of care from staff who understand the importance of a holistic approach to development.

• Specialist Intervention Services (SIS):

Our SIS department provides psychological support to young people and their families. The programmes are supported by research and best practice models complemented by links to national and international research centres.

Tailored Throughcare And Aftercare:

Young people leaving any of our services are supported in their move to their next stage. Young people leaving the Safe Centre receive rehabilitative support if they enter any of our other services, such as a fostering placement. Young people leaving any of our residential services or our community services also receive tailored support which can include vocational training and transitional employment at KibbleWorks, our collective of social enterprises.

Society Profits With Kibble

Kibble has a long history of being open, transparent, collaborative and innovative, with good working practices. Guided and governed by local trustees, Kibble's charitable mission is firmly focused on providing a better and brighter future for young people. We believe this mission can be most effectively delivered through a social enterprise business model, reinvesting profit in the organisation and not distributing this to shareholders, owners or investors.
