

Prohibited and Restricted Items

The following items may not be taken by anyone into the secure perimeter for reasons of safety and security:

- Adhesives / Foil / Cling Film / Elastic Bands
- Aerosols
- Alcohol
- Bags / Rucksacks
- Bank / Credit Cards
- Cameras
- Cans / Glass Bottles / Energy Drinks / Protein Shakes and Associated Products
- Chewing Gum
- Cigarettes, Tobacco, E-Cigarettes/Vapes, and Cigarette Papers
- Cooked Meals or Food Items
- Drugs (Inc. over the counter medication)
 - Including over the counter pain medication (i.e., Paracetamol & Ibuprofen)
 - Prescribed medication should be cleared with the duty manager
- Fireworks
- Glass Objects
- Hats
- Keys (excluding Safe Centre Issued)
- Knives / Tools or Sharp Objects
- Matches and Lighters
- Mobile Telephones (Excluding Kibble issued work mobiles)
- Money
- Opened Packets or Bottles
- Putty / Sand / Plasticine / Play-doh / Blu Tack / Sticky Tape
- Scarves / Ties / Lanyards
- Sewing Kits / Needles
- Spiral Bound Books
- Staples
- Tipp-Ex
- Weapons

The following items are prohibited in the interest of care and control:

- Pornographic, racist, or offensive literature and audio-visual material in any form
- Material which promotes offending
- Material which portrays anyone in an offensive or degrading manner
- Material which is offensive on religious, sectarian, or spiritual grounds
- Material portraying excessive violence
- Computer discs, CDs, DVDs, and Videos of indeterminate origin – unofficial copies

The above list also includes all items with negative logos or connotations, pro-drug, sectarian or offending messages, excessive jewellery and clothing with studs or other attachments with harmful potential.

What constitutes such items is at the discretion of house management. The Safe Centre registered manager reserves the right to modify this list as required. Under certain circumstance items contained within this list may be allowed in, this must be approved by a director.

Failure to comply with this policy could result in either disciplinary action or denial of access.
